### **Fairview homes in on Veitch to lead expansion**

Fairview New Homes has appointed Dwyer Director, Giles Veitch, to drive its expansion into mixed-use development.

Veitch is to target redundant industrial and commercial sites in addition to surplus public sector land after joining Fairview last week as Land Acquisition Director. His move from Dwyer to Fairview follows several months of speculation in the market.

Fairview, whose strengths are in land acquisition, planning, law, remediation and design, has cemented its reputation as a developer that buys land unconditionally when most housebuilders buy sites subject to planning permission. However, Fairview is less prominent in mixed-use development than many of its peers.

Among Veitch's purchases for Dwyer is a 12-acre former hospital site in Highgate, north London.
